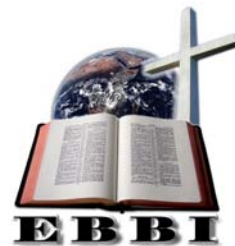

 - Administration approval is necessary if you wish to move out of the dorm.
 - Acceptance as a dormitory resident does not guarantee that you will continue in that dorm.
 - All bills will be paid in a timely manner.

Distance from school: About 1 km, or 12 minutes walk

Cost: Room and Board – \$500 per month.

- Payments are made at the EBBI administrative office.
- Payments are due on the first of each month.
- Upon approval, students may have these charges added to their student bill.

Separate arrangements must be made for phone & internet if desired.

The dorms:

This EBBI dorm is one side of a duplex. The upstairs area is reserved for the dorm parents. The main floor has a living room and kitchen, and will be used in common by everyone in the house. Downstairs are two rooms for students. Bed and desk are provided, so students do not need to bring any furniture. Shower, laundry facilities, and a microwave are also available downstairs.

Occupancy: A maximum of two students per room.

What to bring, or purchase upon arrival:

- Linens, pillow & blankets. The upper bed is a single, the lower is a double.
- Accessories and decorations such as desk lamp, hangers for clothes, etc.
- Personal items such as toiletries, clothing, books, computer, etc.

House rules:

Students are expected to observe the standards outlined in the student handbook. These are intended to guide the student to maintain a good testimony and to help in interpersonal relations. Details relating to dorm life can be discussed later, but general rules would include the following:

- Meals
 - Meals will be provided on a regular basis by the dorm parents.
 - Students may fix some of their own meals if desired.
 - Students must inform dorm parents if they will not be available for meals.
- Cleanliness
 - Keep things clean. This includes the bedroom, common areas, washrooms, etc.
 - Students should willingly help with housework. Some of the tasks may include cleaning floors and washrooms, shovelling snow, mowing grass, etc.
- Visitors
 - No visitors after 10pm
 - Bedrooms are off limits to people of the opposite sex.
- Courtesy
 - Avoid loud music.
 - Respect the fact that you are sharing a home with others.
- Curfew
 - 11pm curfew (except for work and approved special events)
 - Ask Administration for permission if you want to stay overnight with a friend.
- Moral standards
 - No tobacco, alcohol, or music of questionable nature will be permitted.
 - No pornography or suggestive materials in print, music, or video format
- Pets
 - Do not bring pets – they will receive better care at home.
