In 2014 Canada instituted a new process in order to issue students from foreign countries study permits to study in Canada which includes the right to work part-time. EBBI is in the process of working towards becoming a Designated Learning Institution to be able to be part of this program. International Students

Emmanuel Baptist Bible Institute is in the process of being authorized under federal law to enrol non-immigrant foreign students. It is our intent to train these students for ministry in their homeland.

All students should follow the standard application guidelines above. In addition, international students will need to prepare for the following:

Applicant's whose first language is not English should take the **TOEFL** and have the results sent to EBBI. The test may be accessed online at <http://www.ets.org/toefl>

1. Apply for the appropriate study permit from Immigration Canada <http://www.cic.gc.ca/>
2. Maintain a current passport.
3. Be prepared to furnish proof of sufficient funds to cover education costs. This proof may be in the form of a letter from parents, church or bank manager.
